The lovely meandering Loire river, with its light atmosphere produces every style of wine from dry whites, through off-dry rosé, to firm fruity reds and classic sparkling wines. At the Atlantic end is the unique muscadet appellation. Splendid Sauvignon wines are to be found towards the eastern end of the Loire. In between lies Anjou-Touraine, a region noted for fine rosé wines, sturdy reds, dry to sweet Chenin-Blanc and traditional sparkling wines.

..is the biggest fine wine producing area in the world, the pace-setter for the entire industry. Whether the choice is Grand Cru Classé wines, Cru Bourgeois or Petit Château, there is a wide selection. The Merlot dominated Wines from the Libournais (Right Bank) are packed with fleshy, plummy fruit, whereas the blackcurrant and cedar notes of Cabernet Sauvignon, found in Médoc wines (Left Bank) and the reds from the Pessac-Léognan / Graves have a tighter, more structured character, often needing more cellaring time before reaching their prime.

The ageing process requires a minimum of one year in barrel and one year in bottle for Crianza, one year in barrel and two years in bottle for Reserva and two years in barrel and three in bottle for Gran Reserva wines.
